Triving Description - The Tahoe Forest Hospital is located at 10121 Pine Avenue (APN 18-630-08), on the south side of Donner Pass Road within the Town of Truckee, State of California. Access to the project site is via Pine Avenue or Levon Avenue. The project site encompasses approximately 7.4 (Public Facilities). The General Plan land use designation is Public Hospital / Office

Office.

The Tahoe Forest Hospital District (TFHD) through the Measure C Bond Resolution has embarked upon an improvement program for the purpose of enhancing critical medical services and upgrading existing building facilities to meet state-mandated seismic safety standards as well as current code requirements. State seismic standards required by Senate Bill (SB 1953) mandates TFHD to decommission portions of the main hospital building for clinical and mission critical functions, including the Birthing Center, Respiratory Therapy, Pharmacy, Dietary Kitchen, Medical Records, Skilled Nursing Facility improvements, the TFHD proposes to expand and improve emergency room services to ensure code compliance and access to life-saving care and to long-term care for seniors, and cancer care.

The following is an outline of the planned facilities improvements and a description of the physical site changes associated with those improvements:

Cancer Center - Construct a new 34,235 S.F Cancer Center fronting on Donner Pass Road. The first floor includes 20,307 S.F. and will house a relocated and expanded Cancer Center. The second floor includes 13,928 S.F. of shelled hospital programs. This new building will replace the existing 10,575 S.F. building that currently serves as the hospital's business offices, finance and data center.

Central Energy Plant and Engineering Upgrades - The Central Energy Plant (CEP) expansion will include two new buildings totaling 2565 S.F. and demolition of a 492 S.F. existing building. The addition of the larger modern facility will provide additional generator capacity, additional chiller capacity and improved technology for hospital communications. The expansion is limited to upgrades to current building standards.

Skilled Nursing Expansion - Construct a new 3,514 square foot Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) addition on the west side of the south wing of the Hospital that will result in seven patient rooms, replacing the six existing SNF this addition and renovation are support spaces, nurse station, clean/soiled utility rooms and patient and public support spaces.

Emergency Department - Improve and modernize the Emergency Department (ED) by constructing approximately 5,665 sf of additional floor area north of and used for records storage, a portion of the existing ED floor area will be Expansion and future expansion space for diagnostic Imaging.
